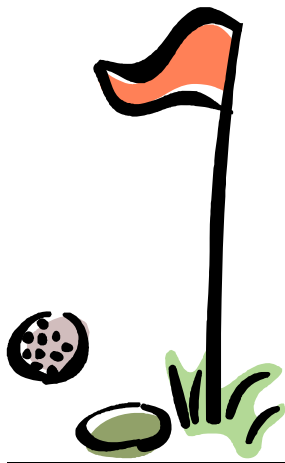

Chase's Corner

A dry and warm April gave way to a cool, wet May. The maintenance staff has been very busy trying to keep up with the constantly growing grass. We have completed the mulching of all beds. The curb project around the small practice green is also complete with the addition of new asphalt. We are currently working on putting a crisp, clean edge around all of the bunkers.

Last year we reported the presence of Eurasian Milfoil in several of our irrigation ponds. This non-native, highly invasive species of weed prevented us from maintaining our ponds at an acceptable appearance level. During the first week of May, we were able to make an aggressive herbicide application that has been very effective on this weed. Our results have been very positive thus far

and we will continue to monitor the situation and make adjustments as needed.

Turf Tip

As we move in to the summer, I receive many questions about lawn watering strategies. The best time of day to water is in the early morning hours. This allows the grass to stay dry for the most amount of time possible. Dry grass is less susceptible to turf diseases. Deep, infrequent watering is also recommended as this promotes healthy root establishment. For example if you are watering every night for 15 minutes you should adjust this to 30 to 45 min every third day.
