Chase's Corner

An unusually dry and warm April allowed the maintenance staff to get a lot of things accomplished. We have planted 3 new Swamp White Oak trees along the left of 1 South fairway to replace those lost by recent storms. You may have noticed that we have re-contoured several of the fairways including the widening of 7 East fairway. We have also added more natural no-mow areas in order to better define and shape some holes. This month we will be finishing up the mulch, edging bunkers, and paving around the small practice green. We are also scheduled to begin greens aerification the day after Memorial Day.

Turf Tip

If you have some bare areas in your yard now is the time to seed. Be sure to rake these bare areas with a metal rake in order to expose the soil. Good seed to soil contact is essential for seed germination. Keep these areas moist until the plants have germinated. A top coating of straw will help maintain moisture. Important reminder: If you have applied a crabgrass preventer this spring do not attempt to seed until the fall. Crabgrass preventer will not allow new grass seed to germinate.

Proper Attire for the Golf Course

Now that golf season is here please remember our dress code: **appropriate attire, including suitable footwear, must be worn at all times by members and guests** while on the golf course and/or practice areas. Shirts without collars (for men) and tank top shirts (for men and women) are not permitted. Denim pants or shorts, (jeans or jean shorts, any color) are not permitted during the Golf Season. Shorts for men must be Bermuda length: (inseam length of eight or more inches).
